

Theta Xi Fraternity Scholarships

Theta Xi Fraternity was founded on April 29, 1864 at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, New York. Since that time we have initiated over sixty-four thousand brothers into the bonds of our brotherhood, and the future promises continuing success as we move through the twenty-first century.

The purpose of Theta Xi is to provide a college home environment for its members in which fellowship and guidance lead to mental, moral, physical, and spiritual growth. To that end Theta Xi actively supports college and community efforts to make individual members and chapters more mature and useful units of society. Through its alumni and undergraduate leadership Theta Xi assists each member to develop:

- The highest G.P.A. he is capable of achieving
- Habits that lead to better mental and physical health
- Sincerity in his association with others and confidence in himself
- Responsibility to chapter, college, community, and country
- Leadership that comes from practicing democratic self-government
- Interests and activities outside regular studies that employ spare time to advantage
- Spiritual understanding that provides a reservoir of strength to draw upon when faced with adverse conditions

All True Men Scholarship (\$300)

To qualify for the All True Men Scholarship you must be a senior male with a cumulative GPA over 3.0, and attending Iowa State University in fall 2010. This award is based off the true values of all members nationally in Theta Xi; the recipient must show exceptional characteristics in terms of leadership, scholarship, community service, and personal desire to succeed.

To be a finalist for this form you must fill out the form completely and correctly, falsified information will result in being disqualified automatically. We will select at most 40 applicants to receive a phone interview, and the top 20 will be awarded a personal interview during his orientation at Iowa State.

Winner will be notified by July 31st 2010, and money will be awarded upon verification of attending Iowa State University as a full time student fall 2010.

Note: You do not have to become a member of Theta Xi to be awarded this scholarship.

Jean Hempstead Scholarship (\$300)

The Jean Hempstead Scholarship requires the same minimum requirements as the All True Men Scholarship, in addition to accepting a bid to join Theta Xi Fraternity upon entering classes in fall 2010.

Winner will be notified by July 31st 2010, and money will be awarded upon verification of attending Iowa State University as a full time student fall 2010.

Note: It is possible to be awarded both the All True Men Scholarship as well as the Jean Hempstead Scholarship.

Jean Hempstead graduated from Iowa State College in 1926. In the 1930s Jean was on the faculty of the engineering school. Jean started to work with Theta Xi in the late 1930s and became an honorary initiate in 1940. He remained an active supporter of the Chapter until he was called to duty for World War II. After the war, Jean served as Chapter Advisor in 1948 and 1949, and then left to join the original faculty of the Air Force Academy. Jean retired from the Air Force Academy in the mid 1960s and returned to the faculty of Iowa State; where he again started working with the Chapter and served on the Mu Advisory Board. Jean retired from Iowa State in 1974 and became an active volunteer for many causes in the Ames area. He brought his commitment to volunteerism to the Chapter. He remained an active volunteer until his late 90's. He was a regular supporter of the Chapter with his time and money. Jean attended his last Chapter event in the spring of 2007 at the age of 102. Jean passed away in the spring of 2008 a few months short of his 104th birthday.

Randall J Doran Scholarship (\$300)

To be eligible for the Randall J Doran Scholarship you must be a senior male in high school, attending Iowa State in fall 2010, and also be very involved in activities outside of school.

Winner will be notified by July 31st 2010, and money will be awarded directly to the recipient in January, after completing one term of study, and the recipient is enrolled for continuing study.

An undergrad student and current active member Randall Doran has donated \$300 dollars for a scholarship to be available to the most deserving incoming freshman committed to Theta Xi Fraternity at Iowa State. Randall was initiated in Theta Xi fall 2008 and since his initiation he has set high goals for the future of the fraternity.

Randall graduated from Harlan Community High School and received recognition in academics, lettered in four sports, as well as lettering in band twice. He was also the treasurer of the National Honor Society his senior year. Theta Xi is looking for a new member who has high goals and will strive to advance the fraternity throughout their college career.
